

Argentina is playing in the BNP Paribas World Team Cup men's event for the 22nd time and was once a finalist in World Group 2 in the days when the men's event consisted of two competitions. More recently, Argentina earned a best result of fifth in the men's event in 2017 before finishing sixth last year to earn direct entry for Israel. Once again, 2017 ITF World Champion Gustavo Fernandez leads the Argentinian team, having started 2019 by winning his second Australian Open title. While Fernandez is ranked inside the world top three, Ezequiel Casco and Agustin Ledesma both have career-best rankings inside the top 20. Fernandez is also a former two-time champion at the Cruyff Foundation Iunior Masters, an event at which Ledesma was also a two-time finalist.
