

South Africa earned double success at the 2019 BNP Paribas World Team Cup Africa Qualification, winning both the women's and men's events. Kgothatso Montjane – more commonly know in wheelchair tennis circles as KG Montjane – and Mariska Venter earned South Africa's victory in the women's event without dropping a set and beat Kenya in the final. South Africa now contests the women's event at the BNP Paribas World Team Cup finals for the eighth time and for the first time since 2015. Montjane is Africa's most successful female wheelchair tennis player, having reached a career best world ranking of No. 5 and contested all four Grand Slams.
