

Netherlands secured an unprecedented 30th women's crown on home soil at the 2018 BNP Paribas World Team Cup, having only missed out on the 1994, 1999 and 2017 titles since the first women's event in 1986. Netherlands continues to have the most strength in depth of any women's team, with Marjolein Buis, Diede de Groot and Aniek van Koot all ranked inside the world's Top 10. All three also won medals at the Rio 2016 Paralympics and have one multiple Grand Slam singles titles between them. De Groot finished 2018 as ITF World Champion for the first time, Van Koot having achieved the same feat in 2013.
